

Signs and Symptoms of Periodontitis for Non-Surgical Periodontal Therapy (NSPT)

Effective nonsurgical periodontal therapy is based on an accurate combination of periodontal disease assessment and treatment. Emphasis will be placed on reviewing different types of advanced instruments for safe and effective calculus removal during patient care.
